Other NLUs making it to the top 30 include National Law Institute University (NLIU) Bhopal [12th], National Law University and Judicial Academy, Guwahati [13th] National Law University Jodhpur [14th], Maharashtra National Law University (MNLU) Mumbai [17th], Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law (RGNUL), Patiala [20th], Gujarat National Law University (GNLU), Gandhinagar [21st], National Law University, Cuttack [22nd], Dr. Ram Manohar Lohiya National Law University (RMLNLU) [24th], National University of Advanced Legal Studies (NUALS), Kochi [26th] and Damodaram Sanjivayya National Law University (DSNLU), Visakhapatnam [30th].

The IIRF rankings are based on the following 7 parameters:

- 1. Academic Excellence
- 2. Research
- 3. Placement Performance
- 4. Corporate Interface
- 5. Placement Strategies and Support
- 6. Teaching Learning Resources & Pedagogy
- 7. Future Orientation

IIRF is a non-government ranking framework in India conducted by IIRF Centre for Institutional Research (ICIR). IIRF Research is published in a monthly magazine on higher education called 'Education Post' since 2012. The Federation for World Academics (FWA) guides the methodology and industrial feedback and plays the role of mentor for IIRF ICIR in India.
